iMake Create cool stuff and learn new skills by making a different project each week. **Thursdays at 3:30 p.m.** at the Main Library. **Ages 10-18.**

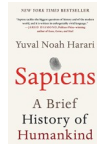

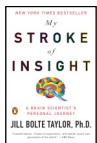
